Website <http://www.anc3c.org>**ANC3C RESOLUTION NO. 2008-004****Resolution Regarding a Grant for the Implementation of the Call Box Project in Cleveland Park, Cathedral Heights, and MacLean Gardens**

WHEREAS certain residents of the neighborhoods of Cleveland Park, Cathedral Heights, and McLean Gardens have formed a Call Box Art Project Committee (CBAPC) to plan for and oversee the recycling of the fire and police call boxes in these three neighborhoods into public art; and

WHEREAS the CBAPC has requested ANC 3C financial support for the Call Box Art project in these three neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS the average cost of recycling a call box into public art is reported to be about \$2,500 on the average per call box; and

WHEREAS Cultural Tourism DC will support the project in the amount of \$17,250; Cleveland Park Historical Society, \$11,250; and

WHEREAS contributions from other organizations and neighborhood residents will be sought for the outstanding balance; and

WHEREAS finances will be handled by the Cleveland Park Historical Society, a 501 c3 organization, using an account specifically established for the Call Box Art project; and

WHEREAS the CBAPC is planning and will oversee the implementation of recycling all 23 fire and police call boxes in Cleveland Park, Cathedral Heights, and McLean Gardens into public art, requiring that call boxes be repaired as necessary, painted, and art pieces reflecting various aspects of social and cultural history be created and installed in each call box; and

WHEREAS ANC 3C encourages the efforts of neighborhood residents acting alone or in community groups to improve the aesthetics or amenities of our neighborhood,

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that ANC 3C grant to CBAPC the sum of \$1000 (one thousand dollars) as a measure of support for the Call Box Art Project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chair of ANC 3C or her designee is authorized to represent ANC3C in this matter.
