**Resolution Regarding HPA#07-452 at 3403 Rodman Street**

WHEREAS Mark Kaufman, the owner of the single-family home at 3403 Rodman Street, within the Cleveland Park Historic District has applied to the Historic Preservation Review Board (“HPRB”) for concept approval for a four story rear addition, an elevated rear deck and the addition of two dormers on the front-facing roof of the house; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has heard from neighbors immediately adjacent to 3403 Rodman Street who have expressed concerns about the size and scale of the proposed rear addition; and

WHEREAS the rear of 3403 Rodman Street is clearly visible from 34<sup>th</sup> Street, NW, which runs perpendicular to Rodman Street:

THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED that ANC3C has no objection to the proposed front-facing dormers on the roof of the house; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that ANC3C finds that the proposed rear addition, four stories in height, which substantially increases the footprint of the existing house to be excessive in size and scale for the house and the immediate neighborhood; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that ANC3C recommends that the proposed addition be reduced in both height and depth to be more consistent with the size and scale of the existing house and other adjacent houses in the neighborhood; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that ANC3C does not object to the rear deck in concept, but suggests that it be scaled back proportionately with the rest of the scaling back of the addition that the Commission recommends; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that ANC3C has concerns that the sensitive ravine area immediately behind the house contains mature trees that could be compromised or damaged by construction, and, thus, the Commission recommends that concept approval include comprehensive tree protection measures; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chair, Commissioner Beckner, or their designee is authorized to speak for the Commission with respect to this matter in all other proceedings.
