ANC3C RESOLUTION NO. 2009-030

Resolution regarding parking on the south side of the 2500 block of Calvert Street NW

WHEREAS, on the south side of the 2500 block of Calvert Street, NW, there is a portion of the curb lane marked “no parking” and “no standing,” and

WHEREAS, the residents of the neighborhood respect this parking restriction signage, and

WHEREAS, the parking restrictions are regularly and frequently violated by tour buses, taxis, van services and trucks, even though the Shoreham Hotel has a bus staging area in the back of the Shoreham Hotel, and

WHEREAS, in particular these tour buses, taxis, van services and trucks frequently idle their engines, disturbing the peace and quiet of the neighborhood and harming the air quality, and

WHEREAS, over the years community leaders have made many unsuccessful attempts to resolve this problem with the Shoreham Hotel and the District Parking Enforcement, and:


Whereas vehicles continue to idle, contrary to the clearly posted signage and neighborhood requests,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT ANC 3C has determined, along with the Shoreham North Condominium Association (the property across the street from the restricted parking area) that the best response to this situation is to change the signage to allow parking while retaining a prohibition on idling bus parking, thereby allowing the space to be filled with personal vehicles; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT ANC 3C strongly urges DDOT to allow only car parking at this location and sign this area for Residential Parking Permits, which is consistent with this block of Calvert Street; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Chair and Commissioner Kummings are authorized to represent the Commission on this matter.
